

Scholarship at the Doctoral School

Doctoral students can take part in various mobility programmes, such as:

- ☐ Erasmus+ mobility for studies (1 or 2 semesters in one of partner universities) and for traineeships (2 to 12 months in a company abroad)
- ☐ PROM programme financial support for scholarship exchange of PhD candidates and academic staff (active participation in a conference or obtaining materials for a PhD thesis/a library query in an institution abroad)
- □ Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange different research programmes, short and long term exchanges

The University of Szczecin also offers accommodation in student houses, with moderate fees.

Accepted candidates will receive administrative support with legal issues, e.g. visa, residence permit.
