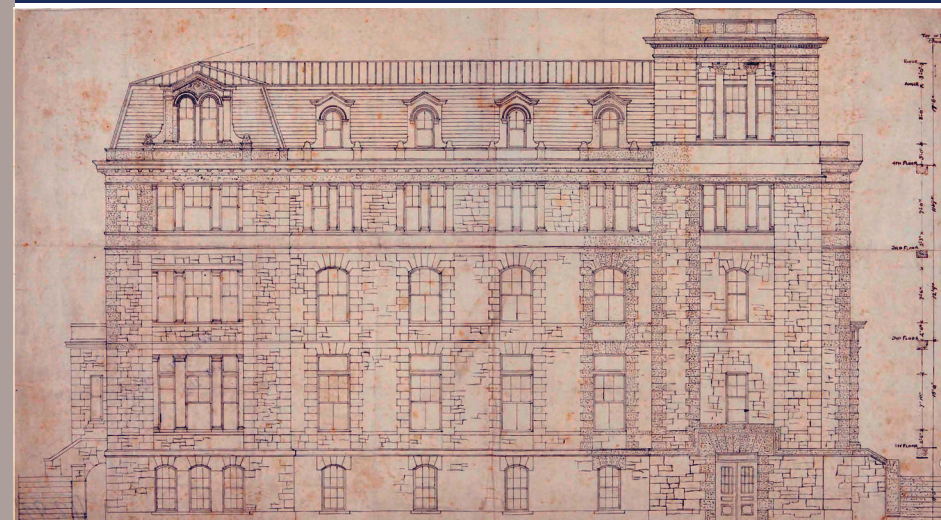
Bogaziçi University Summer Term is an intensive seven-week program that offers more than 300 courses. International students may take three courses.
